Red Hook WIFI was the only community nonprofit selected to share the \$30 million investment program

The Red Hook Digital Stewards install, maintain and promote Red Hook WIFI as they prepare for a career in technology. In a recent RFP issued by the NYC Mayor's office, the Digital Stewardship model was referred to as an example of programs the city aims to fund
- As a member of NYC Mayor Bill De Blasio's Broadband Taskforce, helped to craft New York City's equitable strategies for digital inclusion, including the installation of free broadband service for NYCHA residents, restructuring franchise agreements of incumbent ISP's, equitable distribution of LINK NYC kiosks, and significant investments in broadband resources for all New Yorkers
- Developed Digital Media Bootcamp, a media training program implemented in partnership with a local arts organization and public high school in which students create marketing videos for local businesses
